

LITTLE SPIDER LAKE

235 Acres



This lake is a sleeper for big musky. It is much overlooked as a walleye lake and is one of the area's best northern lakes.

Very good coontail bar extending to deep water- excellent walleye and northern. Large Bay with scattered weeds- good musky.

Shallow, heavy weedbed- good panfish and northern.

Very fast dropping weedbed- good musky, northern and some big walleye.

Entire shoreline is lined with coontail and dropping fast- good musky drift.

"Center bar"- the #1 spot on this lake. All sides drop into deep water. North half is good for big northern & walleye- south half is very good for musky.

Excellent weedbed- fish for all species.

Shoreline with both logs and weeds- good musky drift.

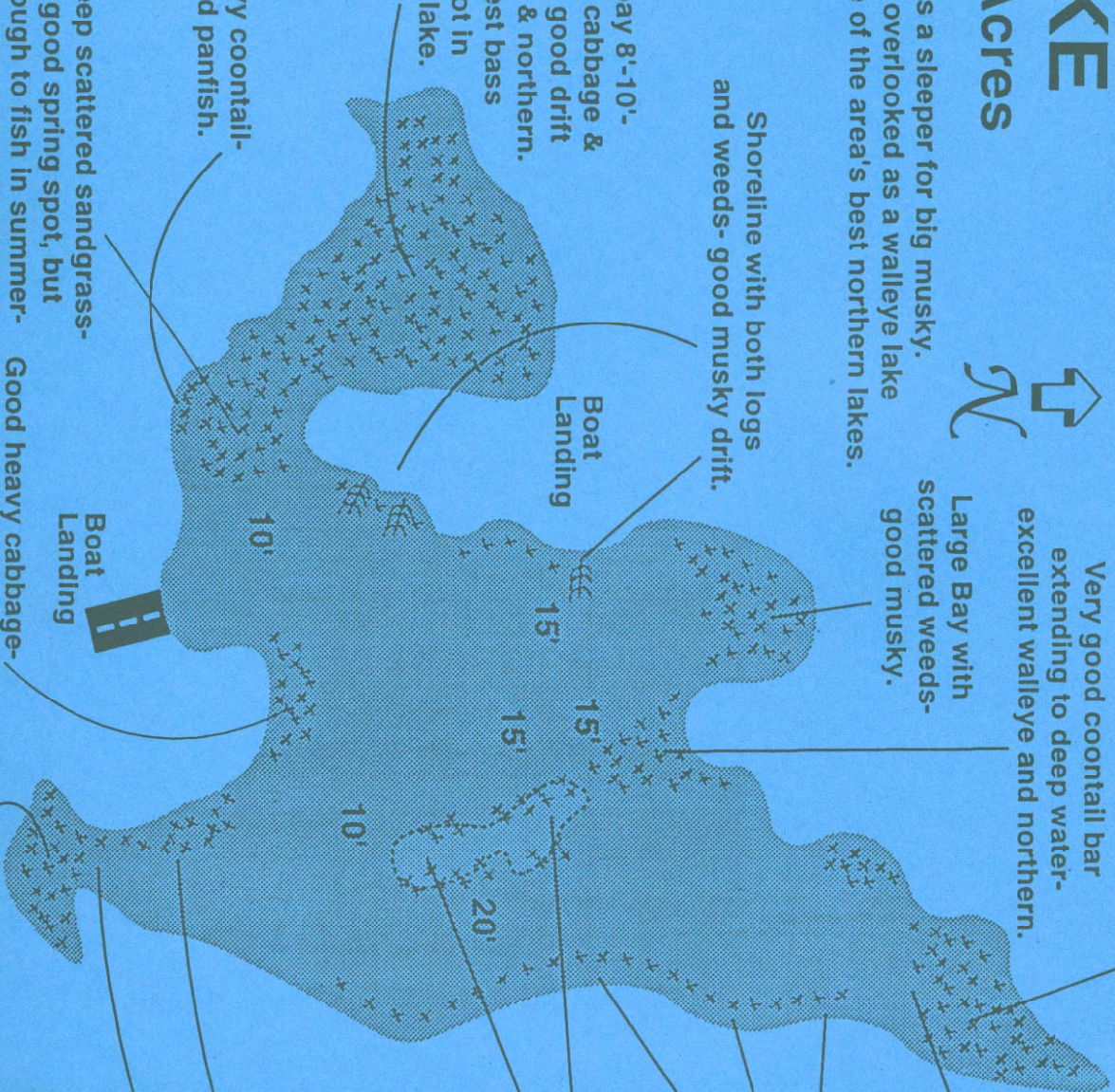
Entire bay 8'-10'- scattered cabbage & coontail- good drift for musky & northern. The best bass spot in the lake.

Heavy coontail- good panfish.

Deep scattered sandgrass- good spring spot, but tough to fish in summer- northern and walleye.

Good heavy cabbage- edge holds nice northern and musky.

Heavy weedbed- good spring walleye & northern.
